Sealed Bids for the construction of the **2017 North Huron Street Water Main and Sanitary Sewer Replacement, Project No. 17039** will be received, by the **City of Cheboygan**, at the office of the **Cheboygan City Hall, 403 North Huron Street, PO Box 39, Cheboygan, MI 49721**, until **2:00 PM** local time on **May 11th, 2017**, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read. The Project consists of:

2100 LF of existing 14" cast iron water main will be upgraded to 12" PVC water main including one (1) hydrant and; 1800 LF of existing sanitary sewer main will be upgraded to 24" PVC sanitary sewer, including laterals and precast manhole structures along North Huron Street between Lake Street and Backus Street.

Bids will be received for a single prime Contract. Bids shall be on a lump sum and unit price basis, with additive alternate bid items as indicated in the Bid Form.

Printed copies of the Bidding Documents may be obtained from the Issuing Office, during the hours indicated above, upon receipt of a non-refundable payment of **\$100** for each set. Checks for Bidding Documents shall be payable to "**Gourdie Fraser, Inc.**". Upon request and receipt of the payment indicated above plus a non-refundable shipping charge **if the bidder has requested "Overnight" shipping**, the Issuing Office will transmit the Bidding Documents via delivery service. Partial sets of Bidding Documents will not be available from the Issuing Office. Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including Addenda if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office.

Alternatively, Bidding Documents are also available on compact disc or through a File Sharing site (as portable document format (PDF) files) for a non-refundable charge of **\$25**, including shipping via overnight express service.

This project is funded by a CDBG grant through the Michigan Economic Development Corporation, and thus, attention is called to the fact that not less than the minimum salaries and wages as set forth in the Contract Documents must be paid on this project, and that the Contractor must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of their race, color, religion, sex or national origin. Bidder qualification requirements and the conditions of employment and requirements of federal prevailing wage rates, Segregated Facility, Section 3 of the HUD Act of 1968, Section 109 and Equal Opportunity are noted in the Bidding Documents.

Each Bidder must deposit with their Bid, security in the amount and form as specified by the conditions provided in the Information for Bidders. Bids not accompanied by a proper Bid bond or certified check in the amount stated in the documents, or received after the above date and time will not be considered. Fax transmittals of Bids or Bid bonds will not be accepted.

The Owner reserves the right to waive any informalities or to reject any or all Bids.

No Bidder may withdraw their Bid within 90 days after the actual date of Bid opening.
