 - 6. This permit is being issued for the maximum time allowed and no extensions of this permit will be granted. Initiation of the construction work authorized by this permit indicates the permittee's acceptance of this condition. - 9. Prior to commencement of any dredging authorized by this permit, the entire dredged area shall be enclosed with a turbidity curtain to prevent off-site siltation. The turbidity curtain shall be installed to extend from the bed of the waterbody to a point above the existing water's surface. The turbidity curtain shall be maintained for the duration of the project and shall be left in place after completion of dredging until all disturbed sediments have settled.
- 10. The permittee is cautioned that excessive dredging resulting in the impairment of the structural integrity of seawalls on neighboring riparian properties is subject to civil damage litigation.
- 11. All dredge/excavated spoils including organic and inorganic soils, vegetation, and other material removed shall be placed on upland (non-wetland, non-floodplain, or non-bottomland), prepared for stabilization, and stabilized with sod and/or seed and mulch in such a manner to prevent and ensure against erosion of any material into any waterbody, wetland, or floodplain.






HANDICAP PAVEMENT SYMBOL DETAIL NO SCALE








CONCRETE WALK DETAIL






